

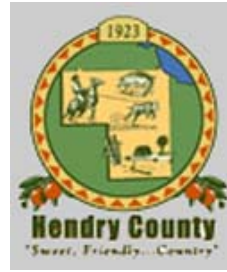
HENDRY COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PATHWAY PLAN

Project Objective: Creation of a Comprehensive Pathway Plan for Hendry County.



Project Summary: Land Planning Solutions partnered with Kimley-Horn and Associates/Urban Resource Group (KHA/URG) in early 2009 to assist in the creation of the Hendry County Comprehensive Pathway Plan. Specifically, LPS headed up the public involvement component of the project through the development of a Public Involvement Plan (PIP) and the facilitation of seven (7) community workshops. These workshops were critical in gathering broad-based input and feedback from County residents.

Additionally, LPS hosted the School Administrators Workshop to identify how pathways can improve students' access to elementary, middle and high school campuses throughout the County. The priorities identified during this workshop were integral to the development of the plan's final recommendations and findings.

The Comprehensive Pathway Plan was unanimously approved by the Hendry County Board of County Commissioners in December 2009, following approval from the Florida Department of Transportation.

COMPREHENSIVE PATHWAYS PLAN MAJOR ISSUES:

- ◆ Identify existing legislation, policies & programs affecting bicycles and pedestrians
- ◆ Identify & inventory existing bicycle & pedestrian facilities, including opportunities and constraints in the network
- ◆ Identify, evaluate and prioritize a ranking of bicycle & pedestrian travel & transportation improvements
- ◆ Develop pathway standards for public and private development
- ◆ Develop an implementation process for obtaining the identified goals and objectives
